As you may be aware, WVIA has showcased and supported the academically and artistically talented students in our region through programs such as *Scholastic Scrimmage* and *Artist of the Week*, as well as the popular *WVIA's PBS Kids in the Classroom* program, among others.

In addition, our students will have access to the comprehensive PBS Learning Media. Drawing from critically acclaimed PBS programs like NOVA and American Experience, our teachers will have access to more than 30,000 videos, images and articles to enrich classroom instruction, collaborate custom lessons and activities, and review pre-made assessments.

While we realize that the PSSA's are just one way to assess the growth of our students and that the score isn't always indicative of the progress that our students are making, we do strive to have our students perform to their maximum abilities. We have added a Math Coach this year for grades K through 6 in an effort to provide more curriculum support for our staff. We are confident that our staff will continue to provide your child with the best possible educational programming and administration wants to provide our staff with as many supports and resources as possible.

As I have mentioned several times in the past, the Carbondale Area School District is proud to welcome back 16 students to our campus.
